



PTFF-12 – “Royal Flying Doctor Service (RFDS), Australia”

The RFDS – “The Flying Doctor” – is an emergency and primary health care service for those living in the remote and regional areas of Australia, who are unable to access a hospital or general medical practice due to the vast distances of the Outback.

The Service is a federation of four “Sections” containing a number of bases from which aircraft are dispatched:

Central Operations
South Eastern Section
Queensland Section
Western Operations.

Suggested Aircraft:

Queensland Section
Beechcraft B200 King Air
Pilatus PC-12
Cessna 208 Caravan

Flight Schedule:

1. Fly from Rockhampton (YBRK) to deliver radio spares to Longreach (YLRE) - 341nm.
2. Fly from Longreach (YLRE) to Blackall (YBCK) and deliver new emergency generator – 87nm.
3. Return to Rockhampton (YBRK) from Blackall (YBCK) – 285nm.

NOTAMS:

Total flight distance 713nm.
