



## PTFF-13 – “Tanker Repairs”

---

The Overseas Shipping Group (OSG) operates the largest tanker/container fleet in the world. One of its important routes is petroleum from the Gulf of Mexico to the Port of New York.

The 80,000 tonne tanker, “OSG Liberty” has suffered engine problems and has diverted to the Port of Savannah in Georgia, for essential repairs. Spare parts are required to be airlifted to Savannah.

### **Suggested Aircraft:**

Boeing B747-8F or appropriate aircraft

### **Flight Schedule:**

1. Load marine engine spares from Cummins Diesel Agency at Elkhart Mun, IN (KEKM) and fly to Savannah Intl, GA (KSAV) – 620nm.
2. Offload and fly to Fort Wayne Intl, IN (KFWA) - 564nm.
3. Load Bilge Pump spares from “Shureflo” Company and fly from Fort Wayne Intl (KFWA) to Savannah Intl (KSAV) and offload – 564nm.

Total flight distance 1,748nm.
