



## PTFF-42 – “Trans-India”

The rapid extension of Imperial Airways took place in the early 1930's with the first service from London to Calcutta in July 1933. The service was extended to Rangoon in September 1933.

The sector between Karachi and Rangoon was flown for Imperial Airways by Trans-India Continental Airways.

6. Rangoon/Yangon (VYYY) - 268nm.
