



PTFF-46 – “US Contract Airmail Flights (2)”

The Airmail Act of 1925 (Kelly Act) authorised the US Postmaster General to award contracts for the delivery of US air mail to commercial carriers. Contract airmail routes became known as “CAM’s.”

CAM 20 was awarded to Colonial Western Airways 1927

CAM 8 was awarded to Pacific Air Transport 1926

CAM 29 was awarded to Southern Air Transport 1929

Route Cleveland-Hopkins (KCLE) to Buffalo-Niagara (KBUF) – 165nm.

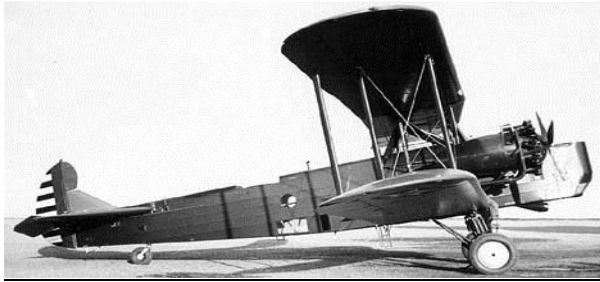
2. CAM 8– Ryan-1
