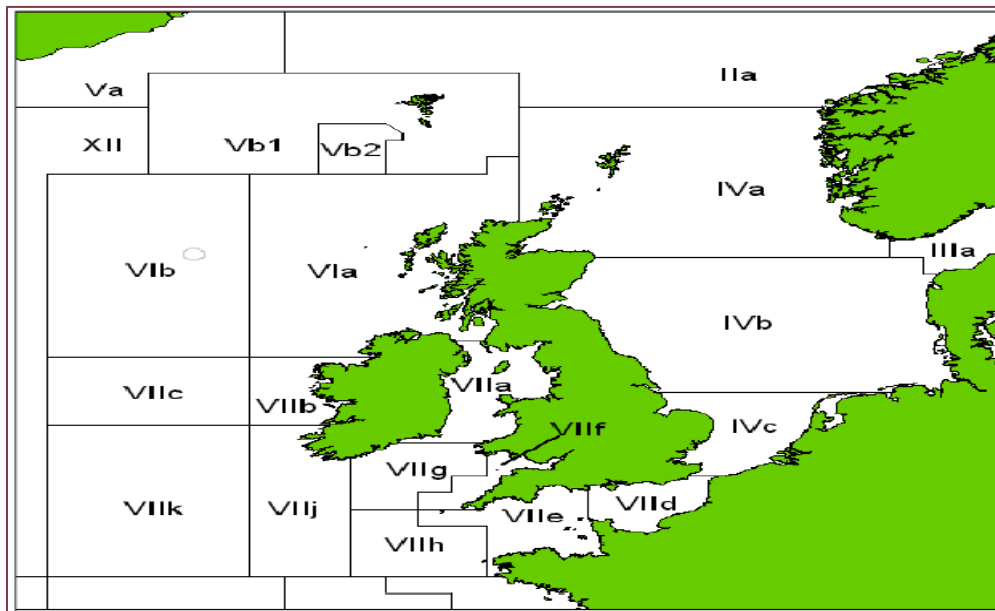




PTFF-50 - Fisheries Protection (1) UK

In general, International Law prohibits foreign vessels from entering within 12 miles of a nation's coastline for the purpose of fishing. The UK Fisheries Protection Agency provides both marine and aerial surveillance of territorial waters to monitor foreign vessels and also protect the environment from "over fishing"
