Lynx Air International was established in 1989. Based in Florida, Lynx offered freight and private mail services and was the first airline to fly from USA to Cap Haitien, Haiti. Lynx also flew to the Bahamas Islands and for the US Government to Guantanamo Bay, Cuba.
