Suggested Aircraft:

Douglas DC-9 Boeing B727.

Flight Schedule:

1. Load consignment of diamonds, produced by the Yetwene Mine at Dondo (FNDU) and deliver to 4th February Airport at Luanda (FNLU) - 462nm.
2. Load mining supplies at Luanda (FNLU) and deliver to Catoca Mine at Saurimo (FNSA) - 431nm.
3. Load consignment of diamonds produced by Cariango Mine at Porto Amboim (FNPA) and deliver to Luanda (FNLU). Return to Porto Amboim (FNPA) with mining engineering personnel - 230 nm.
4. Load fuel supplies at N'zagi (FNZG). Fly to Maquela (FNMQ). Unload fuel. Load unserviceable mining equipment and return to Luanda (FNLU) - 589nm.
