



FF-112 – “First Trans-Pacific crossing by Asian Airline”

Formed in 1941, Philippine Airlines (PAL) was the first Asian airline to fly across the Pacific Ocean. In 1946 a charter flight by PAL flew 40 US Service personnel from the Philippines to California.



Suggested Aircraft: Douglas DC-4

Flight Schedule:

1. Manila Intl (RPLL) (Original airport Makati City no longer exists) to Guam (PGUN) – 1,385nm
2. Guam Intl (PGUN) to Wake Island (PWAK) – 1,304nm.
3. Wake Island to Johnston Atoll (FS9 – PJON/FSX - JON) – 1,365nm.
4. Johnston Atoll (PJON) to Honolulu Intl (PHNL) - 715nm.
5. Honolulu Intl (PHNL) to Oakland (KOAK) – 2,090nm.
