Suggested Aircraft: Boeing 747-8F, Boeing 737F, Transall C160D, EADS Casa 295M (Or appropriate aircraft)

Flight Schedule:

1. Transport heavy mining equipment from Ambouli, Djibouti (HDAM) to Bole, Addis Ababa (HAAB) - 301nm.
2. Transport mining equipment from Bole, Addis Ababa (HAAB) to Gambella (HAGM) - 256nm.
3. Load fuel and supplies at Gambella (HAGM) and transport to mining site Tippi (HATP). Return workers to Gambella (HAGM) - 156nm.
4. Transport workers from mining site Tume (HAMJ) to Gambella (HAGM). Load fuel and workers and return to Tume (HAMJ) - 300nm.
5. Load fuel and supplies at Gambella (HAGM) and transport to mining site at Mizan Teferi (HAMT). Return to Gambella (HAGM) with medevac patient - 180nm.
