



## FF-125 – “Vayudoot Airline”



Vayudoot Dornier 228-201

Vayudoot (“Messenger who rides the wind”) was an Indian regional airline established in 1981 and based at Delhi-Safdarjung to service north-east India where surface transport facilities were inadequate. In 1985 Vayudoot commenced an inland Night Airmail Service (NAMS) for the Indian Postal Service.

**Suggested Aircraft:** Dornier 228, Fokker F27-100

**Flight Schedule:**

1. Delhi-Safdarjung (VIDD) to Jaipur (VIJP), to Nagpur (VANP) - 461nm.
2. Kolkata (VECC) to Varanasi (VIBN) to Nagpur (VANP) - 531nm.
3. Mumbai (VABB) to Nagpur (VANP) - 368nm
4. Chennai (VOMM) to Hyderabad (VOHY) to Nagpur (VANP) - 285nm.
