



FF-157 – “Transport of Wine – France”

France produces 7-8 billion bottles of wine per annum; with its wine making industry dating back to the 6th Century. A decline in domestic consumption means an increased requirement for exports in competition with the wines produced in the New World.



Suggested Aircraft: Appropriate transport aircraft.

Flight Schedule:

1. Load Loire Valley “Muscadet” wine at Nantes (LFRS) and deliver to Heathrow, London (EGLL) - 264nm.
2. Load Alsace “Pinot Noir” wine at Strasbourg (LFST) and deliver to Frankfurt (EDDF) - 97nm.
3. Load Bergerac “Montbazillac” wine at Bergerac (LFBE) and deliver to Rome (LIRF) - 543nm.
4. Load Burgundy “Côte de Beaune” wine at Dijon (LFSL) and deliver to Lisbon (LPPT) - 804nm.
5. Load Languedoc “Crémant de Limoux” wine at Montpellier (LFMT) and deliver to Copenhagen (EKCH) - 795nm.
