Ansett New Zealand was a wholly-owned subsidiary of Ansett Australia, serving the domestic cargo and charter market. Founded in 1987, the airline was the result of Ansett's desire to expand into New Zealand after relaxation of regulations in the aviation sector. After being sold to News Corporation and later Tasman Pacific Airlines, the airline became a franchise of Qantas, before liquidation in 2002.
