Learjet 35

Suggested Aircraft: Learjet 35, Beechcraft King Air 200, Cessna 208.

Flight Schedule:

1. Collect patient from Cape Romanzof. Fly from Bethel (PABE) to Cape Romanzof (PACZ). Return to Bethel, transferring patient to Yukon-Kuskokwin Regional Hospital - 270nm.
2. Fly from Fairbanks (PAFA) to Fort Yukon (PFYU). Collect female patient and infant and fly to Neonatal Unit at Alaska Native Medical Center at Anchorage (PANC) - 471nm.
3. Fly medical supplies from Soldotna (PASX) to Kodiak (PADQ). Return to Soldotna - 340nm.

NOTAMS:

Cape Romanzof (PACZ) is an ex Long Range Radar Station and is unattended apart from civilian maintenance personnel. Runway is approx. 4000' in length.
Total flight distance 1,081nm.
