



## FF-169 – “Europe Airpost”

Europe Airpost operates mail and cargo flights for the French postal service. It was originally part of Air France from 1947-1991 and assumed its current name in 2000; when it commenced services for the French National postal service-La Poste. ASL Aviation of Ireland acquired the airline in 2008 and it will eventually be re-branded as ASL Airlines France.

**Suggested Aircraft:** Boeing B737-300F, Boeing B737-400F.
