Cargo Flights - Oil & Gas Industry:

1. Load supplies at Fairbanks Intl (PAFA). Deliver to Deadhorse, Prudhoe Bay (PASC). Continue to Stevens Anchorage Intl (PANC) with engineering staff - 866nm.
2. Load unserviceable generators at Ugnu-Kuparuk (UBW) and fly to Fairbanks Intl (PAFA) - 334nm.

Department of Defense Flights:

3. Load Army personnel at Allen AAF (PABI) and ferry troops to Elmendorf AFB (PAED) for repatriation - 200nm.
4. Load military personnel at Elmendorf AFB (PAED) and fly to Allen AAF (PABI). Offload and continue to Eielson AFB (PAEI) - 253nm.
