



FF177 - Druk Air – Bhutan



Druk Air, founded in 1981, is the national airline of Bhutan. The airline operates cargo and passenger flights, mainly from Paro-Thimpu from a runway recently extended to 6,600 ft. The airport is at 7,333ft ASL, surrounded by mountains rising to 16,000 ft ASL.



Suggested Aircraft: Airbus A319-100, ATR 42-500

Scheduled Flights:

1. Paro-Thimpu (VQPR) to Gaya (VEGY) - 290nm.
2. Baghdogra (VEBD) to Paro (VQPR). Return to Baghdogra - 146nm.
3. Paro-Thimpu (VQPR) to Guwahati (VEGT). Return to Paro - 280nm.
4. Zia Intl-Dhaka (VGZR) to Rupsi (VERU). Continue flight to Paro (VQPR) - 221nm.
