FF-203 US Contract Foreign Air Mail Airmail Flights "FAM's"



The Airmail Act of 1925 (Kelly Act) authorized the US Postmaster General, to award contracts for the delivery of US air mail to commercial carriers. Contract Air Mail routed to and from a foreign country were designated Foreign Air Mail Routes or "FAM's"

FAM 15 was awarded to Pacific Alaska Airways in 1938
FAM 24 was awarded to American Overseas Airlines in 1945
FAM 32 was awarded to National Airlines in 1946
