Agencio Nacional de Aviacao, Part of the Dept of Operational Safety established in 2006 and headquartered in Brasilia, is the primary regulatory body in Brazil. The Agency is responsible for the regulation and safety oversight of aviation.

Responsibilities include the inspection of airfields and facilities. The US FAA has assessed ANAC as being compliant with ICAO international standards.
