Gold mining in Western Australia is the 4th largest commodity sector in Australia.

The industry produces 50% of all petroleum and mineral resources and employed more than 15,000 workers in 2008.

Remote locations of gold mines require air transport for logistical support and worker rotation.

Virgin Australia Regional has contracts with several mining companies to provide “fly-in fly out” charters to remote mine sites.
