TTA was a “local service” passenger/cargo airline; so designated by the Civil Aviation Board in Texas. Formed in 1947 as Aviation Enterprises the airline flew until 1969 as TTA - then renamed as Texas International Airlines, until a merger with Continental Airlines in 1982. TTA initially operated Douglas DC-3 aircraft known then as “Starliners”.
