



FF-229 US Foreign Air Mail Flights 2



The Airmail Act of 1925 (Kelly Act) authorised the US Postmaster General, to award contracts for the delivery of US air mail to commercial carriers. Contract Air Mail routed to and from a foreign country were designated Foreign Air Mail Routes or "FAM's"

FAM 29 was awarded to Pitcairn Aviation (Eastern Airlines) in 1930

FAM 33 was awarded to Colonial Airlines in 1947

FAM 98 was awarded to Southern Airlines in 1974
